The SM890i-WX is a premium high SPL, high-efficiency surface-mount loudspeaker for distributed or 8 Ω systems. The SM890i-WX incorporates a dedicated 8" treated fiber woofer and a high-power compression horn transducer with a BroadBeamHP® waveguide to deliver a consistent dispersion pattern and superb intelligibility for the foreground music, sound reinforcement and PA markets.

The SM890i-WX uses a 150 W low-insertion loss transformer and a six-position tap switch with a transformer bypass position. Mounting hardware includes SoundTube's proprietary tool-free, low-profile Stealth™ bracket with an integrated internal wedge cam, which allows for stable and precise aiming from 0° to 90°.

Corrosion-resistant materials, including stainless steel grille plus all-aluminum mounting hardware, make the SM890i-WX ideal for indoor/outdoor use.

BroadBeamHP technology delivers a consistent dispersion pattern across the upper registers of the frequency spectrum and delivers maximum edge-to-edge coverage and intelligibility. For the SM890i-WX, SoundTube's proprietary BroadBeamHP technology incorporates a high-frequency compression driver with a 1" exit and an 8" treated fiber woofer. For installer convenience, the SM890i-WX 110° x 85° compression horn can be rotated 90° to tailor the speaker coverage to the venue.

Independent Data Acquisition and Verification

All data for SoundTube speakers is independently collected from and verified by NWAA Labs (www.nwaalabs.com) using their proprietary MACH testing system. All data is collected and analyzed according to ASTM, ISO and AES standards using EASERA, TEF and MLSSA. Full balloon data including both phase and magnitude is compiled into a variety of formats including EASE 4.x, GLL and CLF.

Architectural Specifications

The loudspeaker shall consist of one 203 mm (8") low-frequency transducer and one 36 mm (1.42") compression driver. The system shall include a crossover network and a 150 W low-insertion loss transformer installed in the enclosure. The low-frequency voice coil diameter shall be 34 mm (1.34").

Performance specifications of a typical production unit shall be as follows: Usable frequency response shall extend from 63 Hz - 22 kHz (±10 dB). Measured sensitivity (2.83 V input, 1 M) shall be at least 93 dB. The speaker shall have a nominal impedance of 8 Ω . The speaker shall be available for 25, 70.7, and 100 V modes and include a six-position tap switch with a transformer bypass. The frequency dividing network shall have a crossover frequency of 2.5 kHz with slopes of 12 dB per octave (2nd order) for both low and high pass filters. Rated power capacity shall be at least 150 W continuous (RMS) and conform to EIA-426-B testing. Maximum continuous output at 1 M shall be 115 dB.

The low-frequency transducer shall have a treated fiber cone with treated cloth surround. The high-frequency transducer shall be an offset compression driver with a proprietary 110° x 80° BroadBeamHP waveguide. The high-frequency transducer shall be bayonet-mounted to allow the horn to be rotated 90° to tailor the coverage pattern to the venue.

Installation for the speaker shall be by a tool-free, low-profile bracket with an integrated internal wedge cam for stable and precise aiming from 0° to 90°. Mounting hardware shall be constructed of die-cast aluminum.

The enclosure shall be constructed of injection-molded, glass reinforced ABS. The grille shall be powder-coated steel with tool-free locking system. Overall dimensions including the mounting plate and bracket for the SM890i-WX are 477 mm (18.78") in height by 295.9 mm (11.65") in width by 390.4 mm (15.37") in depth.

The system shall be the SoundTube SM890i-WX for both low and high impedance applications.








Frequency Response
